There are two double bedrooms, both with built-in wardrobes. The fully tiled bathroom has a shower over the bath.

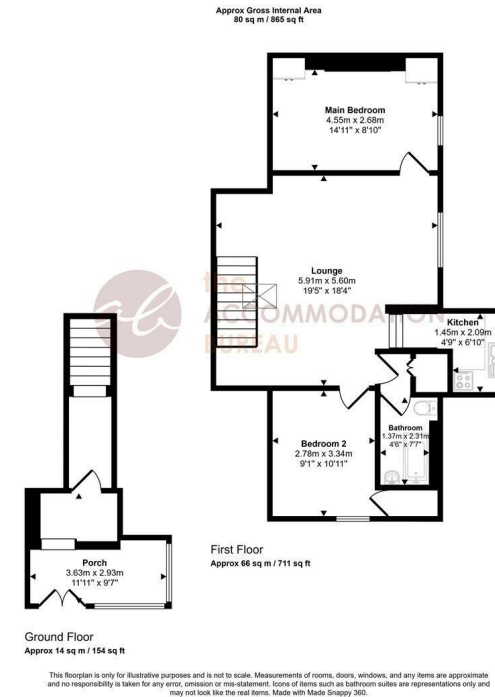

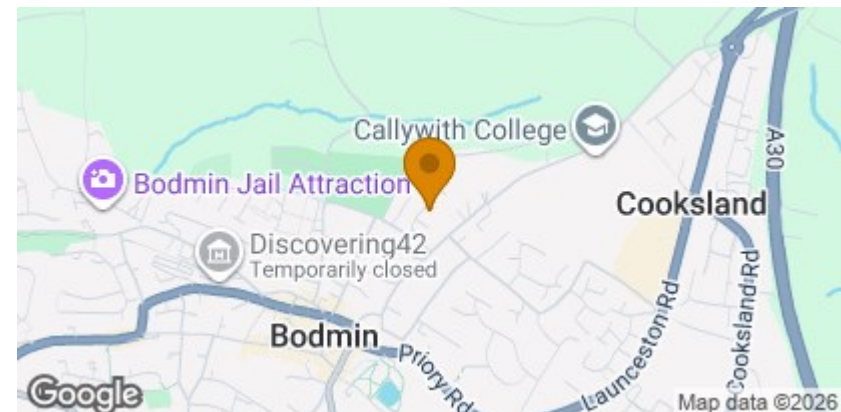

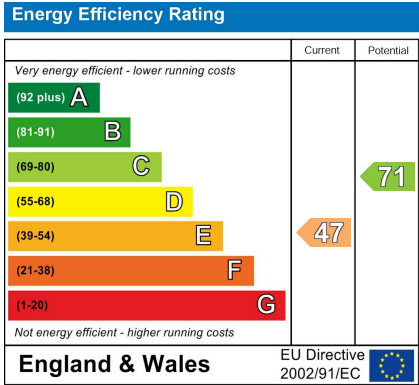
