A light and airy well-maintained ground floor studio flat located in the middle of the town.

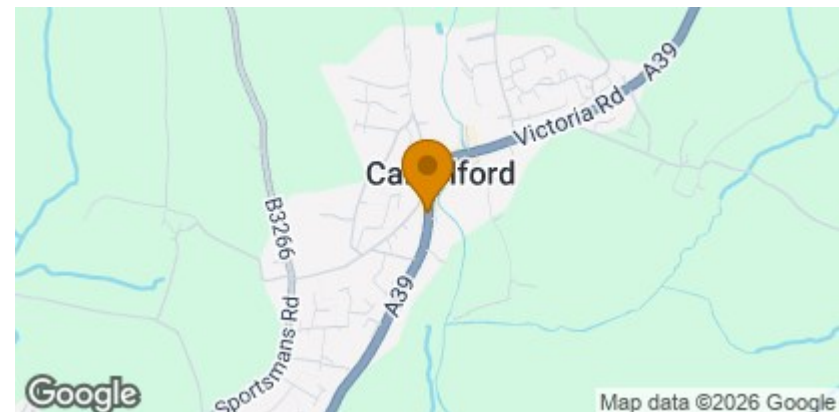

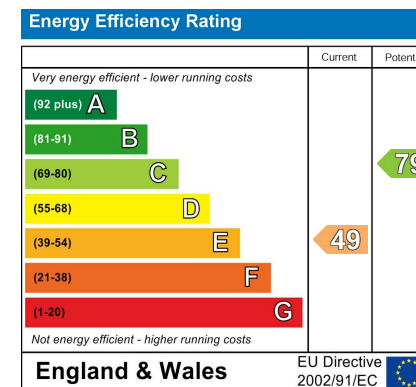
