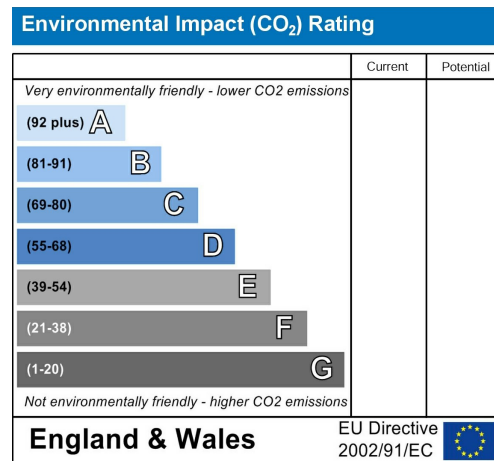
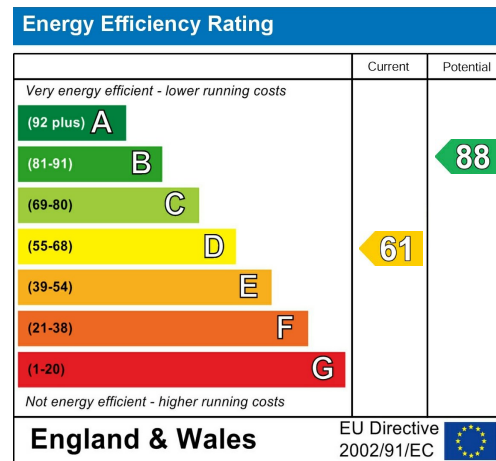
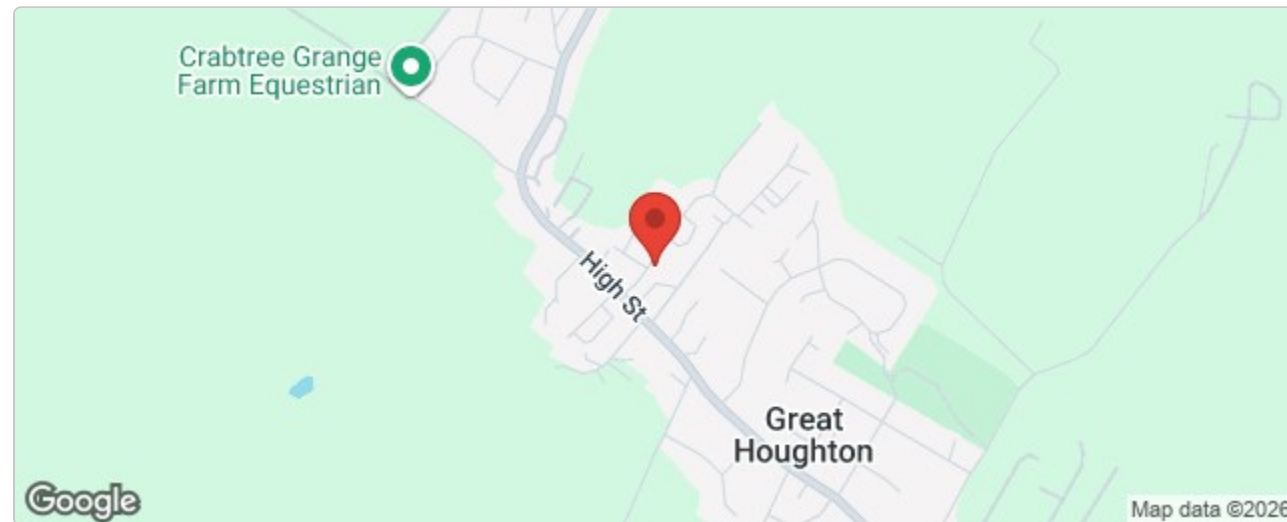


Energy Efficiency Graph
